## IMMIGRATION NEWS: Federal Court Blocks Trump Administration's Termination of TPS

- In February 2025, Homeland Security Secretary Kristi Noem ordered an end to the TPS program, citing concerns that local governments were overwhelmed and that Venezuelan immigrants had connections to the international crime organization **Tren de Aragua**
- On March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, Judge Chen of the Northern District of California ruled in favor of the National TPS Alliance, granting their motion to **delay the termination of Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Venezuelans**. This ruling stops the planned termination that was set for April 4, 2025.

### Why Does this matter?

- Judge Ed Chen's ruling in **NTPSA v. Noem** protects hundreds of thousands of Venezuelan TPS holders who were set to lose work authorization on April 3, and deportation protections on April 7.

### What's Next?
