IMMIGRATION NEWS: CHNV Parole Programs Ending

- Under **Executive Order 14165** signed by President Trump in January 2025, DHS is terminating all categorical parole programs that don't align with the new administration's border security priorities
- On March 21, DHS shared an advance notice announcing the termination of the categorical parole programs for inadmissible noncitizens from **Cuba, Haiti, Nicaragua, and Venezuela (CHNV)**, with an expected termination date of **April 24, 2025**.
- The notice includes the cancellation of pending applications, revocation of employment authorization, and the potential for expedited removal for individuals without lawful status. Similar terminations for other categorical parole programs, including Uniting for Ukraine and Family Reunification Parole, are anticipated in the coming weeks

This means...

- Ending applications for CHNV travel & parole will be canceled,
- Work permits granted under CHNV will be revoked
- Individuals without lawful status may face expedited removal

If you're currently paroled or awaiting travel authorization, know your rights and seek legal advice to explore other immigration options.
