

# Alien Registration Requirements

Effective **January 20, 2025**, all non-citizens present in the U.S. for more than 30 days must register with DHS under the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA §1302), unless exempt.

## **How do I register?**

- **Step 1: Create a MyUSCIS Online Account**
  - \*Each alien submitting Form G-325R must have their own individual USCIS online account.\*
- **Step 2: Submit Form G-325R**
- **Step 3: USCIS review of Form G-325R**
- **Step 4: Attend an appointment for biometrics collection**
- **Step 5: Receive registration documentation:**

## **What happens after proof of registration?**

- Biometrics and background checks required (if age 14+)
- Proof of registration is available online through MyUSCIS account
- Must carry proof at all times (if 18 or older)

## **Address Update Requirement**

- All registered aliens must report any change of address within 10 days through MyUSCIS.

## **Criminal Penalties for Non-compliance**

<b>Violation</b>	<b>Penalty</b>
<b>Willful failure or refusal to register or be fingerprinted (if required)</b>	<b>Up to \$5,000 fine or 6 months imprisonment</b>
<b>Failing to carry registration proof (age 18+)</b>	<b>Up to \$5,000 fine or 6 months imprisonment</b>
<b>Fraudulent registration</b>	<b>Deportability under INA §1227(a)(3)</b>
