
URGENT Refugee Update: USCIS Orders Review of 200,000 Cases and Halts Refugee Green Card Processing: What You Need to Know.

USCIS Director Joe Edlow issued an internal memo ordering USCIS personnel to review and potentially re-interview all refugee approvals from January 21, 2021, to February 20, 2025—approximately 200,000 cases. This memo also orders USCIS to stop adjudicating any applications to adjust status filed by refugees, their derivatives, and follow-to-join refugees admitted during this timeframe.
