U.S. Department of State expands online presence review for visa applicants



Effective March 30, the DOS will **expand social media review requirements** to additional nonimmigrant visa categories, including A-3, C-3 (domestic workers), G-5, H-3 and certain H-4 dependents, K, Q, R, S, T, and U visas, in addition to H-1B, F, M, and J visa applicants already subject to review. Applicants in these categories **must set their social media accounts to “public”** to allow vetting as part of the government’s process to identify individuals who may pose national security or public safety risks.
