EARM IS AN INTERNAL DATABASE USED BY
U.S. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE)
TO RECORD AND MANAGE INFORMATION ABOUT INDIVIDUALS
DURING IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS.

ICE OFFICERS USE THIS SYSTEM TO DOCUMENT INFORMATION
DURING THE **ARREST, DETENTION, AND REMOVAL PROCESS.**

WHAT INFORMATION MAY BE STORED IN EARM:

- BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION
- INFORMATION RELATED TO
REMOVAL PROCEEDINGS
- ARREST AND DETENTION RECORDS
- CUSTODY AND SUPERVISION
RECORDS
- IMMIGRATION HISTORY

WHY THIS MATTERS

RECORDS CREATED DURING ENCOUNTERS WITH IMMIGRATION
OFFICERS MAY LATER BE USED IN IMMIGRATION CASES.

IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS, EVIDENCE OBTAINED THROUGH
UNLAWFUL ARRESTS OR IMPROPER ENFORCEMENT PRACTICES
MAY BE CHALLENGED IN COURT.
