NEWS UPDATE: The U.S. Supreme Court just paused the deportation of a group of Venezuelan migrants in northern Texas

According to CBS News, the Court issued the emergency order, preventing their immediate deportation under the rarely-invoked Alien Enemies Act—a wartime-era law being used by the Trump Administration. Trump has faced scrutiny in recent weeks for invoking the Act.

NBC News adds that at least 28 detainees were placed on buses for deportation, but the buses were abruptly turned around before departure after the Court's intervention.

The Trump Administration had planned to deport the men, allegedly linked to the Tren de Aragua gang, though questions remain about the legal grounds and accuracy of these claims.
