June 2025 US Travel Ban

On June 4, the presidential administration announced a policy restricting the entry of foreign nationals from designated countries into the United States, citing national security concerns.

The ban took effect on June 9, 2025.

Who is Impacted?

The June 2025 travel ban applies to nationals of select countries who were 1) outside the U.S. as of June 9, 2025 and 2) not issued a valid visa as of June 9, 2025

Full Travel Ban:

*Fully suspends entry into U.S. of immigrants and nonimmigrants from:

- Afghanistan
- Burma
- Chad
- Republic of Congo
- Equatorial Guinea
- Eritrea
- Haiti
- Iran
- Libya
- Somalia
- Sudan
- Yemen

Partial Travel Ban:

*Suspends entry into U.S. of immigrants and B-1, B-2, B-1/B-2, F, M, and J nonimmigrant visa holders. Reduces the validity period of all visas issued after June 9, 2025 for nationals from:

- Burundi
- Cuba
- Laos
- Sierra Leone
- Togo
- Turkmenistan
- Venezuela

Possible Future Suspensions:

U.S. will review Egypt's screening and vetting procedures to determine if the country should be subject to the ban

Exceptions to Travel Ban:

- U.S. Lawful Permanent Residents (prior to June 9, 2025)
- Dual nationals of designated countries when traveling on a passport from a non-restricted country
- Visa holders A-1, I-2, C-2, C-3, G-1, G-2, G-3, G-4, NATO-1, NATO-3, NATO-4, NATO-5, or NATO-6
- Athletes and coaches traveling for major sporting events
- Spouses, parents, or children of U.S. citizens applying for permanent residence (certain circumstances)
- Adoptions
- Afghan Special Immigrant Visas
- Special Immigrant Visas for U.S. government employees
- Immigrant visas for ethnic or religious minorities facing prosecution in Iran
- Individuals granted asylum
- Refugees already admitted to the U.S.
- Individuals granted withholding of removal under Convention Against Torture

*Exceptions may be allowed on a case-by-case basis. Criteria for granting exceptions are currently unknown.
